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


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Mel Gibson's Passion of the Christ sequel is to become 'the biggest film of all time'



"It will shock the audience", Jim Caviezal has claimed while talking about Mel Gibson's sequel to The Passion of the Christ. The sequel, The Passion of the Christ: Resurrection, has been in the works for several years. Gibson first revealed the title of the film in 2016, explaining at the time that it will not be a straightforward "chronological telling" of Christ's resurrection. Caviezel, who played the lead role of Jesus Christ in the 2004 film, confirmed in an interview with an online news agency that he is preparing himself to reprise the role in Gibson's long-awaited sequel.The 49-year-old actor was tight-lipped about details for the project. blasphemy.ShahzadMasih, 26, and his 24-yearold, five months-pregnant wife, Shama Bibi, who were from the village of KotRadhakishan in the Punjab province, were accused by local Muslims of tearing pages out of a Quran, following which hundreds of enraged Muslims gathered and burned them alive on Nov. 4, 2014.

In November 2016, an anti-terrorism court had sentenced five men to death and 10 others were given varying jail terms for playing a supportive role in the killings. Later, the court acquitted 93 other suspects in the case the same year.

Christian and other minorities in Pakistan routinely face blasphemy charges followed by "religious" lynching.Pakistan has a notorious blasphemy law, embedded in Sections 295 and 298 of the Pakistan Penal Code, which provide for penalties ranging from a fine to death. The law is often misused to target religious minorities, including Christians, Shi'as, Ahmadiyyas and Hindus, as there is no provision to punish a false accuser or a false witness of blasphemy.

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

Preacher Benny Hinn Admits Endorsing Prosperity Gospel.

Post the death of renowned evangelist Billy Graham, controversial faith-healing televangelist Benny Hinn, said in a stunning confession Wednesday that sometimes he has taken the erroneous gospel too far. He has been criticized for his endorsement of the Prosperity Gospel.

"We get attacked for preaching prosperity, well it's in the Bible, but I think some have gone to the extreme with it sadly, and it's not God's word what is taught and I think I'm as guilty as others. Sometimes you go a little farther than you really need to go and then God brings you back to normality and reality," Hinn, 65, said as he reflected on Graham's death with a ministry colleague in a Facebook Live broadcast (21/02/18).

"We all sadly make the mistake of thinking that this is what God wants and God says 'No, that's not what I want.' It's time to live biblically. You know it all comes down to one thing. Do we love Jesus, yes or no? If we love Jesus then it's all about Jesus. If we don't love Jesus then it's about other things," he said.

During the broadcast Wednesday, one of his colleagues, who has known him for 30 years, said Hinn would give every material thing that he has for the presence of the Lord.

As a pastor, Hinn also said he wants his life to end right with God."We all want to finish right," he said of pastors. "We all start right. Sometimes we, you know, stumble here and stumble there, but when you come right down to it, we all want to finish right. I'm 65 years old, I surely don't want to blow it at this point in my life and I thank you for praying for me. I really mean that."

The Proof of Prophet Isaiah's Existence



The Biblical figure Isaiah who prophesied the coming of the Messiah may have been an actual real person. Archeologists have found an ancient clay seal from around the time he was reportedly alive, marked with his name. Called a bulla, the seal was retrieved from a 2,700-year-old midden in the Ophel, dating it to around 8th century BCE, and it's inscribed with the Jewish prophet's name. It was found just 3 metres from where the bulla of King Hezekiah of Judah, to which Isaiah was an adviser, was found in 2015."We appear to have discovered a seal impression, which may have belonged to the prophet Isaiah, in a scientific, archaeological excavation," said lead archeologistEilatMazar of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.

"If it is the case that this bulla is indeed that of the prophet Isaiah, then it should not come as a surprise to discover this bulla next to one bearing King Hezekiah's name given the symbiotic relationship of the prophet Isaiah and King Hezekiah described in the Bible."The bulla or seal, sadly broken, is about a centimetre (0.4 inches) in diameter, stamped with the name Yesha'yah[u] (Isaiah) in Hebrew letters. Following it were the letters NVY, which are the first three letters of the Hebrew word for prophet, which is spelled nun-beit-yodaleph.



Ny name is Yeshu Das and I am 30 years old. My father's name is BabuMasih and we are residing at a village called

Kharausa, District Pilibhit, Uttar Pradesh, North India. I was born and brought up in a Hindu family that was following the Hindu traditions and customs. As I grew older, my family and I started experiencing many hardships in our lives. To get rid of this, my parents often went to Hindu religious pilgrimages and practiced Hindu rituals, thinking everything could be changed. Vietnamese Christians Attacked, Forced to Renounce Christ

Two dozen Christians in Vietnam were recently attacked by a mob for their faith.The incident happened in the north-western highlands of the country when members of an ethnic group known as Hmong decided to accept Jesus Christ.Their conversion provoked the village chief who threatened to expel the believers from the community if they didn't renounce their new-found faith.

Putnam City Schools will no longer be allowed the Rev. Mike Keahbone of Cherokee Hills Baptist Church to lead the Putnam City High football team in prayer. Over the past two years, Keahbone has become one of the most prominent and visual supporters of the Putnam City Pirates football team as he has led an initiative to get his church community more involved to support players whose parents aren't able to go to the games themselves.Not only was the 45year-old Keahbone designated to serve as the team's chaplain, he has also led the team in prayer before the start of games in the

team's locker room.Although many enjoy the relationships between the church and the team, at least one resident complained to the Wisconsinbased FFRF (Freedom From Religion Foundation).

FFRFadvocates for a strict separation of church and state and regularly pressures school districts and government entities to halt any type of Christian or Jewish practice that could be construed as a government entanglement of religion.FFRF legal fellow Christopher Line sent a letter to Putnam City Schools Superintendent Fred Rhodes in early February arguing

that Keahbone's act of leading the public school football team in prayer before games violates the Establishment Clause of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution." Public school football teams cannot appoint or employ a chaplain, seek out a spiritual leader for the team or agree to have a volunteer team chaplain because public schools may not advance or promote religion," Line wrote. "Similarly, it is illegal for a public school or school-appointed volunteer to organize, sponsor or lead prayers at public school athletic events."

But, we cannot bear his comments. He had raised doubts on Jesus Christ's resurrection, which is the ultimate belief of Christians, the organization's district secretary, I. Pushparaj, told TOI.

"He should apologise for his remarks or police should take action against him", he added.

Choi explained that children are taught to believe that Christianity is an "evil American religion" and that missionaries are never to be trusted."When I grew up in North Korea, I also believed that Christianity was evil and that the cross was a symbol of the devil. Even in nursery school, we had to bow to the pictures of the first leaders of North Korea, Kim Il-Sung and his son, Kim Jong-II," the defector revealed.

"Everything in North Korea revolves around the Kim family. North Korean children are brainwashed so that they will honor the leader of their day. In preschool, the teachers prayed to the leaders at lunchtime. We had to give thanks to the dictators for our 'daily bread,' Now, I realize they stole this from the Lord's Prayer," Choi said. Citizens are also told stories about Christian pastors and missionaries raping and attacking people, creating an evil image in their minds that they are supposed to stay away from.Still, Choi shared his hopes that with advancing technology, children are finding new ways to learn the truth about the world and are wising up to the regime's lies.

"Today's North Korean children are able to discover other beliefs and ways of life through escapees' disseminated information, smuggled USB drives and foreign radio broadcasts in the Korean language. More parents are coming to faith and, when the children are old enough, they will hear about the Bible and the Gospel," the defector said.

"I'm praying that God would open the eyes, ears and hearts of North Koreans of all ages. I truly believe that if believers throughout the world continue to pray with North Korean believers, one day all North Korean children will learn the truth about God and Christianity. One day, they will turn to the cross," he shared of his hopes.



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Canadian Street Preacher David Lynn Arrested in London

A Canadian Christian street preacher and nondenominational ministry leader was reportedly arrested and detained for over 20 hours in the U.K last week after he was accused of making homophobic comments. Preacher David Lynn was released from the Fresh Wharf Custody Base in East London last Wednesday without charge after he was detained a because of day earlier accusations that he called a lesbian woman "perverse" and "sinful" while preaching at a train station in Barking.

Lynn, who pastors at a church in Toronto, Canada, and has preached in the streets for 22 years, leads an organization called Christ's Forgiveness Ministries with churches in Canada.

According to the Christian organization (CLC) that provided the legal representation to Lynn, he began preaching at the Barking station around 3:30 p.m. last Tuesday, where he was joined by a group of supporters.After a woman complained to police about Lynn's alleged comments, he was arrested and taken to the station without having a chance to defend himself or explain his side of the story.

Lynn was held for nearly a day and was interviewed about the incident. He has outright denied the allegations.



Christian Legal Centre CEO Andrea Williams said in a statement after Lynn's release that Lynn's case is another example of how police in the U.K. are too quick to act when trying to curtail the free speech rights of street preachers.

"We are delighted that he has not been charged for sharing the good news of Jesus, and we remain committed to providing expert legal support, free of charge, where street preachers face trouble with the police," Williams explained.
