



20 Christians Severely Injured in Attack on Prayer Meeting in UP

Over 20 Christians have been seriously injured in an assault on a prayer meeting in Uttar Pradesh on July 2. Six of the Christian victims were charged with multiple false criminal charges by the village president, International Christian Concern (ICC) reported. ICC said that a mob of 35 Hindu extremists attacked the meeting and beat the group of over 150 Christians gathered for prayer in Raikashipur village, in the Pratapgarh District, U.P.

According to the Christian body, prayer meetings are held every Monday in Raikashipur village. For the last five years, nearly 300 people participate in the **P-12**

PHILIPPINE PRESIDENT SAYS HE'LL RESIGN IF ANYBODY CAN PROVE GOD EXISTS

July 7, 2018



The Philippine president, who recently sparked outrage for calling God stupid, has courted new controversy in his largely Roman Catholic country by saying he will resign if anybody can prove that God exists. President Rodrigo Duterte, who has had a thorny relationship with the church, questioned anew in a speech late Friday some of the basic tenets of the Catholic faith, including the concept of original sin, which he said taints even innocent infants and can only be removed through baptism in a church for a fee.

"Where is the logic of God there?" Duterte asked in a speech at the opening of a science and technology event in southern Davao city.

The 73-year-old leader said that if there's "one single witness" who can prove, perhaps with a picture or a selfie that a human

was "able to talk and to see God," he will immediately resign.

Duterte, however, suggested that there must be a God or a supreme being that prevents billions of stars and celestial bodies from colliding in a frequency that could have long threatened the human race.

Last week, he was slammed, including by some of his political allies, for calling God "stupid" in another speech, with one Catholic bishop calling him a "psychopath."

Duterte lamented in that speech that Adam and Eve's sin in Christian theology resulted in all the faithful falling from divine grace. Opposition Sen. Antonio Trillanes IV shot back at Duterte by describing him as "one evil man" and his remarks as "very much consistent with the deceitfulness, heartlessness and ruthlessness of his policies."

Presidential spokesman Harry Roque has defended his remarks, saying Duterte has the right to express his opinion on religion and cited the president's previous disclosure that he was once sexually abused by a priest.

Duterte on Friday recalled that experience, when he said he and other students were fondled by a foreign Jesuit priest, who has since died.

Amid the criticisms, officials have arranged a meeting between Duterte and the head of the largest association of Catholic bishops on Monday.

Pressure on Christians Heats Up in Nepal



NEW DELHI (Morning Star News) – In a rash of recent actions against Christians in Nepal, an alcoholic who became violent during an intervention had Christian leaders arrested on forcible conversion charges, and a foreign couple was deported.

Isak Tamang of the Shreejanga Free Church and pastor Dip Rai of the Chengbung Free Church were arrested on July 2 in Taplejung District, in eastern Nepal, accused of forcible conversion and assault. Two other Christians, David Limbu and Shristi Limbu, were arrested in the same case.

An unidentified Christian woman had asked leaders at Shreejanga Free Church to help her husband, who is not a Christian, with his drinking problem, and he was staying on the church premises without access to alcohol, according to pastor Kuber Gurung, a Religious Liberty Forum Nepal (RLF-Nepal) leader based in Dharan.

Canada's apex court rules that biblical Christian views are not part of 'diversity'

In a ruling that is sure to send shock waves through the nation, Canada's Supreme Court ruled 7-2 against Trinity Western University's (TWU) Law School. In effect, what the court declared is that universities must choose between biblical standards and accreditation. Put another way, the court ruled that Christianity and higher education are incompatible.

Here's a brief summary of the case. Trinity Western is a Christian university that requires its students and faculty to live by basic Christian standards. This means that to be a student or faculty member in good standing, you can't commit fornication or adultery, nor can you engage in homosexual relationships. There's nothing surprising about these requirements. There are thousands of schools in North America with similar standards. These include Christian schools from K-12, Christian colleges, Bible schools, seminaries and universities. These standards have long been part of TWU's mandatory covenant, which requires "that all students and faculty pursue a holy life 'characterized by humility, self-sacrifice, mercy and justice, and mutual submission for the good of others.' It requires members to abstain from

using vulgar language, lying or cheating, stealing, using degrading materials such as pornography, and 'sexual intimacy that violates the sacredness of marriage between a man and a woman.'"

Unfortunately, when TWU sought to open its law school, it fell afoul of Canada's LGBT activists and their allies. They argued that TWU was discriminating against LGBT students, because of which students graduating with a bona fide law degree should not be allowed to practice law in Canada.

There was a ray of hope for TWU when a regional court ruled in its favor. But now, "In a pair of 7-2 rulings, the majority of justices found the law societies of British Columbia and Ontario have the power to refuse accreditation based on Trinity Western University's so-called community covenant." In other words, the Supreme Court ruled that if a Christian law school wants accreditation, it must abandon biblical values.

Perhaps more directly than the United States, Canada carries the great and uninterrupted English legacy of liberty under law. Can the heirs of Magna Carta, of John Locke, of William Blackstone — for that matter, of John Stuart Mill — feel anything but unease at the judgment of the Canadian Supreme Court in this case?

The Beyoncé Mass

It is quite startling that a church in San Francisco held a worship service Wednesday (April 25, 2018) night themed on the teachings of Beyoncé, a well-known American singer and lyricist.

Grace Cathedral, an historic episcopal church well-known for its pledge to social justice, held its first ever “Beyonce Mass” as part of a weekly worship series envisioned to uplift the experiences of women and appeal to young worshippers. The Mass was Produced by Grace Cathedral’s contemporary-culture-themed ministry called “The Vine”, founded by the Rev. Jude Harmon, the Mass is one of a three-part series at Grace called “Speaking Truth: The Power of Story in Community,” which aims to tell stories of those traditionally marginalized in Christianity, such as women and people of color. The main attraction of this never heard before service was the presentation of Beyoncé’s songs (“Listen,” “Freedom,” “Flaws and All,” and “I Was Here,” as well as “Survivor,” a hit by Beyoncé’s original girl group Destiny’s Child) backed by a gospel soloist, a choir and

a live band performing them. The sermon was about liberation struggle, the readings were from a speech by civil rights leader Ella Baker, and the scripture readings were by black women, and finally ending the mass with a traditional communion.

HOW IT ALL BEGAN?

The idea originated from a class called “Beyoncé and the Hebrew Bible” led by the Rev. Yolanda Norton, a San Francisco Theological Seminary assistant professor who is specialized in the

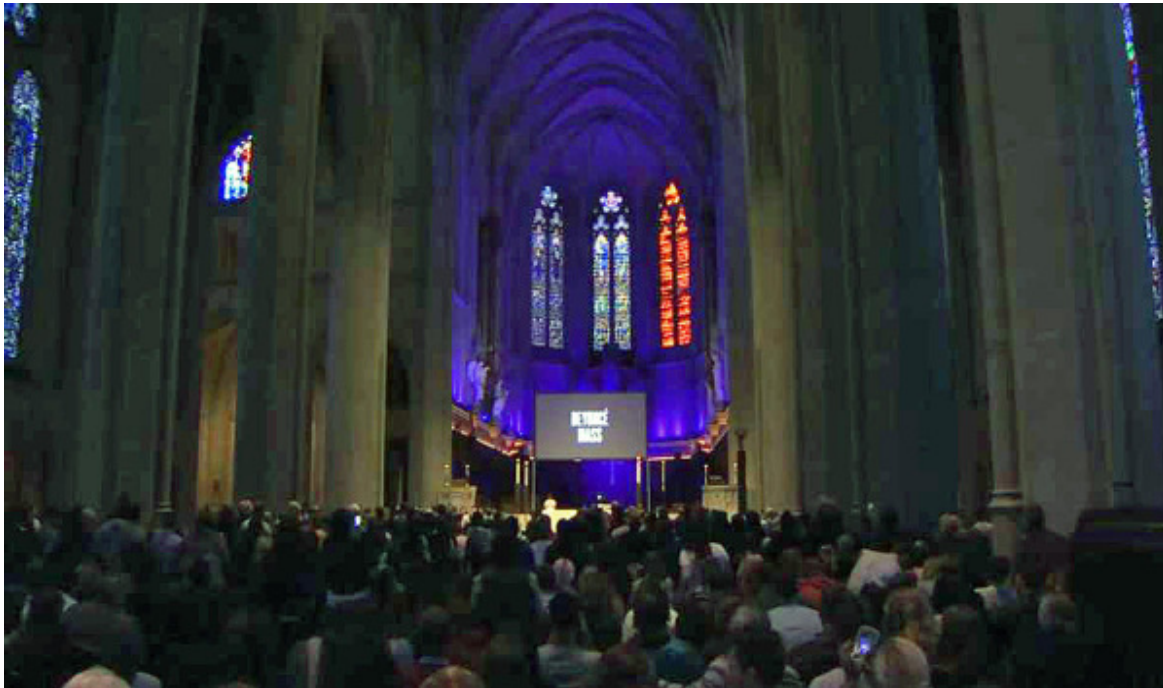

Old Testament. One of her students, Sam Lundquist, is a pastoral intern at the cathedral, and an alliance was born. In Norton’s own words, both the class and the Mass came from a desire to explore female-centric interpretations of the Bible — specifically how biblical texts reflect African American female identity. Her guest sermon Wednesday in the mass reflected these key themes. She said, “When we talk about womanist biblical interpretation, Beyoncé felt like a natural fit”. If we look at the trajectory of her person and her relationships, we can see so many issues black women face and how it can af-

fect how we interpret the text.”

There is no doubt Beyoncé Knowles-Carter is a “natural fit” as one among the most accomplished black women across the globe, she is also one of the world’s best-selling musical artists, with over 100 million records sold and having won 22 Grammy awards. Her 2016 album “Lemonade,” launched with a Super Bowl half-time performance of “Formation” at Levi’s Stadium in Santa Clara, was her most critically acclaimed and was considered one of the year’s best records. Its release was accompanied by an hourlong film with themes of African American history.

THE SERVICE

The service was held on April 25, 2018 at 6: 30 PM. According to the reliable reports, there was an attendance of over 900 people, mostly youngsters, and including a few children. The organizer of the mass is Reverend Yolanda Norton and she leads Beyoncé Mass with a passion and energy that can only be compared to that of Queen Bey (Beyoncé). She sums up the spirit of the service briefly when she describes herself: “I am unapologetically a minister of the Gospel, I am unapologetically a biblical scholar, and I am unapologetically a Beyoncé fan—and I don’t feel like I need to apologize for any of that.”

A report appeared in the website of the Grace Cathedral the very next day had a description that reads, “Grace Cathedral, an historic episcopal church known for its commitment to social justice, hosted its “Beyoncé Mass” as part of a weekly worship series intended to uplift the experiences of women and appeal to young worshippers. The unconventional service featured a sermon about liberation struggle, readings from a speech by civil rights leader Ella Baker, scripture readings by black women, a traditional communion, and of course, the singing of Beyoncé songs.”

IS BEYONCÉ WORSHIPED?

The proponents of the mass would say that it is not about worshipping Mrs. Carter herself, but rather using her contributions in music and other areas to inspire people to attend service, worship the Lord, and empower themselves. Her lyrics drive the sermon in the services. The service focuses on empowering women of color and other minority communities by bringing pop music and religious messaging together. Reverend Jude Harmon, the producer of the mass, told a news agency that Grace Cathedral draws a large LGBTQ and PoC crowd. “The church hasn’t been the best about lifting up those voices,” he says. “Honestly, I think Beyoncé is a better theologian than many of the

pastors and priests in our church today.”

A CRITICISM

Conservative Christians around the globe came up with criticism about the Mass. The social media played a pivotal role in spreading the videos and pictures of the mass instantly and what followed was a flood of hate and disapproval tweets, Facebook posts and live feeds condemning the very act the church committed.

It’s very true that this gathering was not essentially a worship but rather a Christian based Beyoncé Musical Concert. It’s blasphemous celebrity worship that the Bible does not support in anyway. In order to find God or to worship Him, no one ever needs a mediator other than Jesus Christ. No matter how great is Beyoncé’s work, it can never, or will never take any precedence than the work Christ accomplished on Calvary. Moreover, Beyoncé Mass is not the expression of Christianity on Earth. The Mass was born from the reflections and experiences of students enrolled in a course entitled “Beyoncé and the Hebrew Bible” at San Francisco Theological Seminary. The course was created and taught by a scholar Rev. Yolanda Norton who says of her class’s framing, “Beyoncé’s unique status in the world gives me the unique opportunity to narrate the realities of Black women in the church and in the world.” How can such reflections and experiences lead to such severe forms of idolatry?

At the best, it can be considered as an instance for an end time activity as Jesus and the apostles promised to take place. Apostle Paul said to Timothy, “For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths.” (2 Timothy 4:3-4)

Robert Jeffress Accuses Dallas Mayor of Religious 'Hostility' for Vilifying 'Christian Nation' Event.

Outspoken Pastor Robert Jeffress has shot back at Dallas Mayor Mike Rawlings, accusing him of being "hostile" toward his megachurch by speaking out against a billboard advertising an upcoming sermon on how "America is a Christian Nation." Jeffress' First Baptist Dallas has been the center of media attention in the last couple of weeks after the Dallas Morning News published an op-ed that was critical of billboards promoting a June 24 service at First Baptist Dallas that will feature a special message in which Jeffress will outline the historical evidence that America is a Christian nation.

"That is not the Christ I follow," the Christian Democrat mayor said. "It's not the Dallas I want to be — to say things that do not unite us but divide us. I never heard those words, that voice come out of Christ. Just the opposite. I was brought up to believe: Be proud of yours, but do not diminish mine."

The following day, two First Baptist Dallas billboards were removed by billboard company Outfront Media.

In an interview with Fox News Monday night, Jeffress said he doesn't have a problem with the company not wanting to promote a message it disagrees with, pointing out that it is similar to a Christian cake baker not wanting to bake a cake for a same-sex wedding. However, Jeffress opposed the fact that the mayor and the Dallas Morning News op-ed seemed to

have influenced the company's decision. Jeffress cited the Supreme Court's ruling earlier this month in favor of Christian baker Jack Phillips to state that government is not supposed to be "hostile" toward any religion. Jeffress argued that the mayor "does not have the right to weigh in on this" and "disparage our church."

"What we don't support is the mayor of Dallas and his chief communications officer weighing in on this topic, showing hostility toward our church," Jeffress argued in another interview with Fox News on Tuesday. "The Supreme Court just said two weeks ago in that wedding cake case that the government has to be neutral, not hostile toward religion." "And, we believe Mayor Mike Rawlings has shown hostility toward our church," Jeffress added.

Jeffress, who is a Fox News contributor and an informal adviser to President Donald Trump, added that there seems to be a double standard when it comes to what Rawlings feels is divisive.

"A couple of years ago when the American Atheists put up a billboard at Christmastime saying, 'Skip Church, Christianity is Fake News,' we didn't hear the mayor criticizing that or calling that divisive or saying that doesn't represent Dallas," Jeffress said. "But for some reason he feels threatened by the message that 'America is a Christian nation.'" Jeffress

added that the pressure to remove the billboards shows the "hypocrisy of liberalism."

"Whether it is the Dallas Morning News or Mayor Rawlings, liberals are the most intolerant people of all when it comes to ideas they disagree with," he said. "That phrase, 'America is a Christian nation' is actually a quote from John Jay, the first chief justice of the Supreme Court and two Supreme Court rulings."

Jeffress assured that the church has put up 20 more billboards through another billboard company to replace that two that were removed.

Over 6,000 Nigerians in Christian-Identified Communities Murdered or Maimed by Fulani Muslims in 2018

PLATEAU STATE — Church leaders in Plateau State, Nigeria are calling on the government to intervene as a reported 6,000 people in Christian-identified communities have been either killed or maimed by Fulani Muslims in 2018 alone.

"What is happening in Plateau state and other select states in Nigeria is pure genocide and must be stopped immediately," reads a statement released by the Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN).

It said that the violence by the Muslim herdsman is particularly severe in the north and middle belt, and that women, children and the elderly have been affected by the attacks the most. CAN feels that little is being done about the matter, and that the "perpetrators are being deliberately allowed to go scot free."

"We are particularly worried at the widespread insecurity in the country where wanton attacks and killings by armed Fulani herdsmen, bandits and terrorists have been taking place on a daily basis in our communities unchallenged despite huge investments in the security agencies," the statement outlines.

All 12 Boys Rescued From Thai Cave



All 12 boys along with their soccer coach have been rescued from the cave in Thailand, having been stuck inside for over two weeks, in a story that has gripped the world. And some Christians there say the events have served as an opportunity for sharing the Gospel. The third phase of the high-risk operation was completed successfully Tuesday (11th July 2018), as 19 divers entered the cave and ex-

tracted the four remaining boys and their coach, CBS reported. The rescue operation Tuesday lasted nine hours, from the time when the divers first entered the cave until the last person was brought out. The other eight boys emerged Sunday and Monday. Ranging in age from 11 to 16, the young boys went exploring in the cave in the Chiang Rai province of the Southeast Asian

country more than weeks ago and got trapped inside due to monsoon flooding. Rescuers could not locate them for nearly 10 days because of the high waters.

All of the "Wild Boars," the name of the soccer team, have been hospitalized and will remain so for weeks due to weakened immune systems, reports indicate. Authorities will also likely look for signs of Histoplasmosis, which is known as "cave disease," an infection that is "caused by breathing in spores of a fungus often found in bird and bat droppings," according to the Mayo Clinic.

President Trump congratulated the Thai Navy Seals Tuesday morning, calling the rescue "such a beautiful moment."

Bryan Kaui-Pai, who helps lead Grace Bangkok Church in the capital of the country, told a news agency on Monday that the nation was exuberant as each boy was rescued. "When they were found it was almost like a big sigh of relief as a country," Kaui-Pai said.

The rescue operation was exceedingly difficult and hundreds of experts from around the globe were flown in over the past 18 days to facilitate the process. The unfolding story captured the attention of the world as the malnourished boys, some of whom did not know how to swim, were brought out of the cave.

Catholic and Evangelical Soccer Players Go Down on Knees in Prayer at World Cup



Millions around the world witnessed a rare image on Monday at the 2018 World Cup in Russia, when Belgium player Romelu Lukaku, a Roman Catholic and one of the biggest soccer stars in the world, joined in prayers on the field with his evangelical counterpart from Panama, Fidel Escobar.

Eduardo Soto, the director of communications of the World Youth Day Panama 2019, told ACI Prensa on Tuesday that Escobar is an evangelical, while Lukaku, who is the star striker for Manchester United, one of the biggest clubs in the world, is a Catholic.

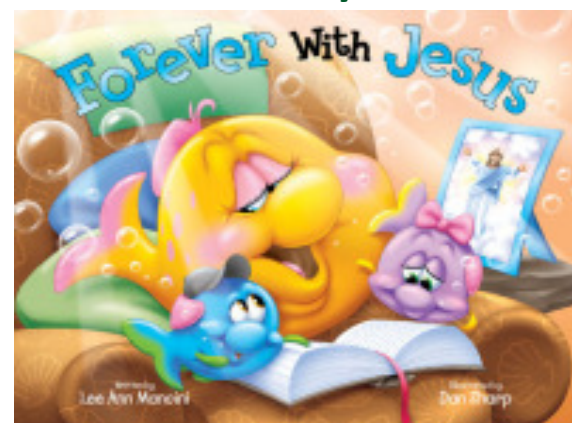
At the end of the group match, which Belgium won 3-0, Lukaku and Escobar knelt on the field together to pray. While it is common for players to individually pray, or pray as part of their own team, it is generally rare to see two from opposite teams come together on the field in such a fashion. "Lukaku and Fidel Escobar kneeling and praying at the final whistle was a beautiful moment for many. Both players may represent different religions and had differing results, yet they found peace in what they were doing," wrote Oscar Flex - a digital

content creator, on Twitter. "Love for the game, God above all," he added. Lukaku, who scored two goals in the game against Panama, has spoken out about his Christian faith on a number of occasions, and has shared his devotion to God on Instagram. In January, the player said that he was considering legal action after the owner of his former English club Everton suggested that he used "voodoo" messages to help him decide to join Manchester United.

Trump Nominates Brett Kavanaugh to US Supreme Court



President Donald Trump has nominated Judge Brett Kavanaugh to the United States Supreme Court to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Justice Anthony Kennedy. In an announcement made Monday evening, Trump stated that Kavanaugh had a "proven commitment to equal justice under the law." "Throughout legal circles he is considered a judge's judge," stated Trump, labeling him a "brilliant jurist." Kavanaugh, 53, was nominated to the District of Columbia Circuit by President George W. Bush and previously worked under Ken Starr, who investigated President Bill Clinton.

On June 27, Justice Kennedy announced that he was going to retire effective July 31 from

the Supreme Court after serving on the bench for 30 years. Nominated by President Ronald Reagan in 1988, Kennedy was often viewed as the "swing vote" of the Supreme Court, serving as tie-breaker for many controversial cases. Kennedy wrote the majority opinions for decisions that advanced LGBT causes, including the 2015 decision *Obergefell v. Hodges*, which legalized same-sex marriage nationwide.

News of the retirement garnered excitement for conservatives like Family Research Council President Tony Perkins stating that he hoped Trump would appoint "a justice who simply decides the cases before them, as the Constitution intends."

Wheaton College Wins 5-Year Religious Freedom Battle Against Birth Control Mandate



Wheaton College has won a five-year battle to fulfil its Christian mission without having to provide services like the week-after pill and abortion-inducing drugs in its healthcare plans. A district court judge has ruled that the government would violate federal civil rights laws

if it forced the Illinois-based Christian liberal arts college to provide some services, which are required by the contraceptive mandate under the Obama administration's Affordable Care Act, against its religious beliefs. The decision permanently protects Wheaton from any current or future version of the mandate, according to the nonprofit Becket Fund for Religious Liberty, which represented the college.

"The government is not above the law — that's why we have civil rights laws. Wheaton should never have had to go to court to protect its rights in the first place. This order ensures we won't have to come back," said Diana Verm, Wheaton alumna and legal counsel at Becket,

'A Living Hell': Some 3,000 Displaced Nigerian Christians in Agony Amid Slaughter



Nigerian Christians have been displaced by the thousands due to mass slaughter in the villages surrounding Jos in Plateau state are in a "living hell" and agony, a watchdog group assisting the victims said.

"The displaced Christians were in a pathetic situation," an Open Doors USA worker, said on Tuesday. "Life has become a living hell for them. They have lost loved ones, houses, and all they labored for in the twinkling of an eye. The agony they are going through is hard to describe.

Open Doors, which along with some indigenous churches is helping bring aid to the people in the area, estimates that at least 3,000 believers were displaced by the slaughter of over 200 people in a series of raids at the end of June.

Christian leaders in Nigeria have said that as many as 6,000 people, mostly women and children, have been killed by Muslim Fulani herdsmen since the start of the year.

Wheaton, which is guided by its religious mission "For Christ and His Kingdom," filed a lawsuit to defend its right in 2012 after receiving no response from HHS to its concerns. The college was founded by abolitionist Jonathan Blanchard in 1860.

The contraceptive mandate, which requires health insurance plans to offer birth control and abortion-inducing drugs, has gone to the Supreme Court five times, and each time the Supreme Court has ruled in favor of protecting religious groups.

In 2013, the Obama administration proposed accommodations concerning the contraceptive mandate, but pro-life and religious liberty groups pointed out that it did not meaningfully expand the "church-only" exemption and amounted to little more than a gesture.

'God Made Humans Male or Female' – UK Doctor Dismissed For Saying Gender is Biological.



British Doctor David Mackereth has lost his job as a government medical assessor because he would not renounce his belief that gender is established at birth.

The 55-year-old Mackereth worked as a physician for Britain's National Health Service for 26 years, mostly in emergency rooms, but was told that in his new position as a "disability assessor" he must identify transgender patients as the sex they said they were, rather than their sex at birth.

Mackereth, a Reformed Baptist, refused and says his free speech rights have been violated over

his religious convictions.

"I said that I had a problem with this," Mackereth said. "I believe that gender is defined by biology and genetics and that as a Christian the Bible teaches us that God made humans male or female."

"I could have kept my mouth shut but it was the right time to raise it," he said. "I don't believe I should be compelled to use a specific pronoun. I am not setting out to upset anyone. But, if upsetting someone can lead to doctors being sacked then, as a society we have to examine where we are going."

On July 2, around 2:00 p.m., the mob arrived at the prayer meeting in several vehicles. They charged into the meeting hall and thrashed the Christians gathered there with wooden sticks. Gunshots were also fired into the air five times to frighten the Christians. During the attack, 20 Christians were seriously injured, 10 motorcycles were damaged, and the furniture, musical instruments and chairs were destroyed.

"I didn't sleep or eat properly for nearly a week now," Ram Kumar Gautam, a 42-year-old

Christian who heads the prayer meetings told ICC.

"The attack on our prayer meeting last Monday has had devastating consequences. Many have serious injuries with their limbs being broken. Also, a false case was booked against six of us under stringent IPC sections," he added. Following the false complaints against Christian victims, the village Pradhan lodged false criminal charges against six Christians, including Gautam, under Indian Penal Code (IPC) sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 452, 323, 504, 506, 392, and 295A.

Children Murdered in Their Beds: Nigeria - the Deadliest Place to Be a Christian



A new wave of attacks by Fulani herdsmen against Christians is leading one international human rights advocate to call on the US Congress to appoint a special envoy to investigate.

"Nigeria is now the deadliest place in the world to be a Christian," explained attorney Emmanuel Ogebe. "What we have is a genocide. They are trying to displace the Christians, they are trying to possess their land and they are trying to impose their religion on the so-called infidels and pagans who they consider Christians to be." Two weeks ago, 238 people were killed in a village massacre in north-central Nigeria. Six of Ogebe's relatives were among the victims.

"From what we have been able to piece together, the husband and his pregnant wife, he tried to take her out of the house to safety and come back for the kids," recalled Ogebe. "But they ran into the herdsmen along the way and they shot him and his pregnant wife and they went into their home and they killed their

four-year-old son and their six-year-old daughter who were asleep in their beds."

He said the Muslim attackers also killed two relatives who were visiting the family during summer break.

Ogebe said thousands of Nigerians have already died in attacks this year, including 500 in Benue State. In April, herdsmen opened fire on members of a Catholic church during their mass. A priest who was serving communion and 18 parishioners were killed.

In another incident, Fulani herdsmen attacked the home of Archbishop Benjamin Kwashi of the Anglican Church of Josh. The archbishop was unhurt, but one person was killed.

"I think one of the things we need the most is prayers... whatever is going on right now has some kind of spiritual underpinnings and I believe if we begin to deal with it from that point, it makes it easier," Oisamoje explained. "After all, the Bible tells us that we do not war against flesh and blood, so we know there are spiritual issues, so we need to pray."

every Monday and people voluntarily attend these prayers," said Gautam. "We don't even talk about conversions, but I am accused of converting people. People

come to our prayer and get healing. That's why people choose to regularly attend the prayers," he added, according to Christians Headlines.com.

World Cup Outreach Teams Detained by Russian Authorities!!



Despite Russian authorities detaining three outreach teams, the ministry known as Mission Eurasia, reports nearly a half million people have been affected by the group's month-long World Cup 2018 outreach.

The organization reported in a news release that authorities in Moscow, Kaliningrad and Ekaterinburg detained the teams for talking with people and passing out Christian literature in public places.

Mission Eurasia's Russia director Pavel Tokarchuk said law enforcement released them without filing charges but did keep their literature, and it's not known if they'll face further repercussions.

However, despite those incidents, Mission Eurasia said participants in the evangelistic outreach handed out around 500,000 pieces of literature, including a special-edition Gospel of John.

In addition, approximately 400 churches hosted World Cup viewing parties and soccer competitions in 50 cities around Russia.

The ministry expects record turnout at upcoming live screenings of the final soccer games. Tokarchuk said Russians are more willing these days to discuss spiritual issues because of national pride in hosting the World Cup and the success of the national

team in the tournament.

"People are excited, and that has provided a real opportunity for sharing the Gospel," he said.

According to the news release, Mission Eurasia's outreach is viewed as an innovative way to share the Gospel despite Russia's restrictions, considered "part of a crackdown on religious freedom in the country."

"Many Christians have found a new courage and boldness for sharing their faith," Tokarchuk said. "We are praying they will continue to be encouraged to spread the good news."

Ultimately, Mission Eurasia believes the World Cup ministry will reach up to 3 million people. Leaders have in the works thorough follow-up programs, anticipating 1,800 home Bible study groups, as well as sports and day camps for up to 15,000 children.

60 Churches Bombed or Burned: Kachin Christians Facing Genocide in Burma



Orthwood Church founder Pastor Bob Roberts worries if the US Congress doesn't act soon, ethnic Kachin Christians in Burma may face the same plight as the Rohingya. He believes prayer and action can make the difference in saving them. Roberts is a member of the Faith Coalition to Stop Genocide in Burma.

Roughly 95 percent of the people of Kachin State are Christian. They were evangelized more than 180-years ago by Baptist missionary Adoniram Judson. Roberts says American Christians need to pray for the Kachin and Rohingya. He also suggests people contact their members of Congress and urge them to help.

Members of the interfaith tolerance group gathered in Washington, DC on Tuesday to detail the plight of the Rohingya, and to warn that the Kachin also face potential ethnic cleansing. Roberts said he was alarmed to learn that the same Burmese military units that have burned villages, and have raped and killed Rohingya ethnics in Rakhine State, are now on patrol in the Kachin State.

"When you radicalize and you create such violence among soldiers that have been raping and murdering, you just don't turn that switch off," he said.

He said military units have bombed or burned at least 60 churches in the past 18-months.
